

Federal Electronic Health Record Enhancements in Capability Block 14



Capability Block 14 is part of a standard plan for the Federal Electronic Health Record (EHR) to enhance existing capabilities, introduce new interfaces, and remain current on software code. The release window is scheduled for February 20–27, 2026. All Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Department of War (DOW), Department of Homeland Security's United States Coast Guard (USCG), and Department of Commerce's National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) facilities that are live with the Federal EHR or affiliated with a live site (e.g., remote services) are part of the release. However, some updates are Department specific, depending on whether the Department uses the platform, capability, feature, or interface included in the release to deliver care at any of their sites. **For Captain James A. Lovell Federal Health Care Center (Lovell FHCC), some updates impact only DOW patient care locations (PCLs) or VA PCLs. PCLs refer to the location where care is rendered.**

End users will gain a comprehensive view of a patient's recent care, optimizing both the time required and the sources of information needed for effective care planning.
